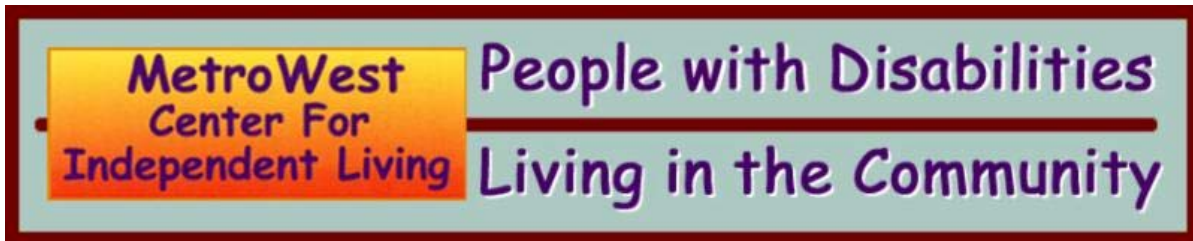

The disability community has lost a good friend and a great advocate with the passing of Tom Hopkins on January 19, 2019. Tom has been active in our community for many years. Early in his life as an advocate, Tom fought the town of Spencer over disability discrimination and access rights. For most of the past twenty plus years Tom worked for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts at the Architectural Access Board. As the executive director of the AAB, he ensured that the state regulations for access were followed in new buildings and applicable reconstruction.

Tom loved woodworking, making ship models and the beach. He and I spent many hours together traveling and developing our firm beliefs in disability rights and the right for all to live free. I will miss Tom, but I know he changed so many lives and his memory will live on.
