The Architectural Access Board (AAB) will hold a public hearing to solicit comments about whether community based residential programs that serve five or fewer individuals in homes situated in single or two family residences and licensed by the Massachusetts Department of Developmental Services ("DDS") should be considered "public buildings" as that term is defined by [G.L. c. 22, Â§13A](#), and thus subject to the provisions of [521 CMR](#).
